








Return to Auchtavan

While attending the Ballater Highland Games in August, 2024, myself and family members (Kristen Decker, my daughter, plus Jance Hawkins and his two sons, Soren and Bowman) were able to visit our ancestral homes in Auchtavan. This is a remote and abandoned farm hamlet (ferm toun) 6 miles northeast of Braemar. The name "Auchtavan" was derived from a gaelic term for "field of 2 goats" which was the price of rent the families paid to the Laird of Invercauld. There were eight tenant families living there and farming the land. The nearest church was the Crathie Kirk a couple of miles distant, and for these families attendance was both a weekly religious and social event.

Six generations of my relatives lived in Auchtovan from the mid 1700's until 1902.

Only three of the existing buildings in the small farming community remain intact: the "Hingin' Lum Cottage," the "Queen Mother's Picnic Cottage," and the "Horse Mill." The other buildings are in ruin with a few walls remaining. Many of the stones were removed from these walls to build up stone fences in the area.



William Bowman and his wife, Margaret MacHardy, took up residence as the first Bowman generation in the mid 1700's.

Their home was named the "Hingin' Lum Cottage" because of the hanging wooden

chimney inside the walls of the house. The single fireplace consisted of a wooden hood and chimney built about 4 feet above the floor along the inside surface of the outer wall; thus, the name "hingin' lum" (hanging chimney).

The "Queen Mother's Picnic Cottage" was also a residence of the Bowman Family for many years. Elizabeth The Queen Mother leased it for "the remainder of her life" as a favorite



picnic venue due to the panoramic view of the valley and Lochnagar. Upon her death the picnic cottage was returned by Queen Elizabeth II to the Invercauld Estate.



John Bowman (1767-1866) was born at the Hingin' Lum Cottage and served as the gamekeeper of the Ballochbuie Forest of Invercauld. He was a highly respected employee of the Farguharson Family as was his son, James Bowman (1813-

1885). James took his father's position as gamekeeper and forest manager when his father's health began to decline. James was loyal to his clan chief and served as an Invercauld Highlander. In 1848 he guided Queen Victoria and Prince Albert as they

climbed Lochnagar and he quickly gained their respect and confidence having brought them safely through an impenetrably dense fog and a torrential storm on the mountain top.

James became the Head Gillie for Balmoral and the Chief Guide for Queen Victoria and the Prince Consort in 1868. He was very athletic and a well-acknowledged competitor at the Braemar Games. Queen Victoria and Prince Albert were



notably impressed with his many abilities, as well as his confident, candid, yet pleasant personality, marking him as one of their favorite Balmoral servants. When he died the Queen and the Royal Family visited his grieving family, provided wreaths for the funeral, and rode in his funeral procession. The Queen commissioned two memorial plaques to commemorate his life and death.

While I am not a direct descendant of James Bowman (he never married and had no children) he remains a family legend. He was an Invercauld Highlander who gave a lifetime of service to his clan chief as well as his sovereign. Returning to Auchtavan and "my roots" has been a soul-felt experience.


